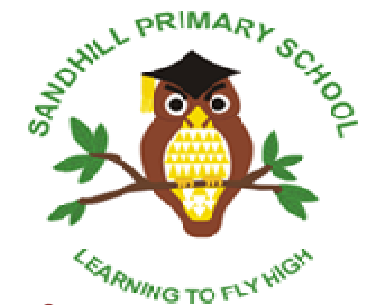

Attendance in January and February was lower than normal due to illness. Please ensure that whenever possible your child attends school.

Did you know...

ATTENDANCE MATTERS

99% - 100%	This is excellent attendance!
Above 97%	Less than 6 days absence a year: Fantastic attendance! Pupils with this attendance have the best possible start to their education.
Above 95%	Less than 10 days absence a year: Pupils with this attendance will be well prepared as they move through the school.
Above 90%	19 days absence over the year: Pupils with this attendance are missing a month of school per year. It may be difficult for them to achieve their best.
Above 85%	29 days absence over the year: Pupils with this attendance are missing 6 weeks of school. It will be very difficult for them to keep up and achieve their best.
80% and below	Missing a day for every week of school. It will be almost impossible to keep up with learning.

Trips

Due to parking on Dearne Street children have to get off the coach on the main road. For safeguarding purposes and teacher's own peace of mind it is our policy that children return to their classrooms and are released from their own doors, unless otherwise stated on the trip letter. This ensures that staff can easily track who children go home with. I appreciate that at times this can be frustrating for parents but we ask that you support us and follow our policy.
